

NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION

In accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Election Code, notice is hereby given that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. on the 21st day of May, 2019, at the regular places of the voting districts in and for said county.

THE PUBLIC OFFICES FOR WHICH CANDIDATES ARE TO BE NOMINATED:

STATE-WIDE (10 Year Term): Two Judges of the Superior Court

COUNTY OF LEBANON (Four Year Terms): Two County Commissioners; One Controller; One Coroner; One Prothonotary & Clerk of Courts; One Recorder of Deeds; One Treasurer.

CITY OF LEBANON (Four Year Term): Three City Council Members

SCHOOL DISTRICTS: Five School Directors at Large (4 year term) in Annville-Cleona, Cornwall-Lebanon, Eastern Lebanon County, Lebanon, Northern Lebanon and Palmyra School Districts. One School Director at Large (2 year term) in Annville-Cleona, Cornwall-Lebanon, Northern Lebanon, and Palmyra School Districts.

MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT JUDGE (6 year term): One Magisterial District Judge in District 52-1-01. This district includes the following election districts: Lebanon 1st Ward, 2nd Ward, 3rd Ward, 6th Ward, and 7th Ward.

BOROUGHES: One Mayor (2 year term) in Jonestown and Myerstown. Four Council Members (4 year term) in Cleona and Richland. Three Council Members (4 year term) in Cornwall, Myerstown, and Palmyra. Two Council Members (4 year term) in Jonestown and Mt. Gretna. Four Council Members (2 year term) in Jonestown. One Council Member (2 year term) in Cleona. One Tax Collector (2 year term) in Cornwall, Jonestown, Myerstown, Palmyra, and Richland.

FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIPS: Three Township Commissioners (4 year term) in Annville and West Lebanon. One Tax Collector (2 year term) in Annville and West Lebanon

SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIPS: One Supervisor (6 year term) and one Auditor (6 year term) in Bethel, East Hanover, Heidelberg, Jackson, Millcreek, North Annville, North Cornwall, North Lebanon, North Londonderry, South Annville, South Lebanon, South Londonderry, Swatara, Union and West Cornwall Townships. One Tax Collector (2 year term) in East Hanover, Heidelberg, North Lebanon, South Annville, and South Londonderry Townships. One Auditor (4 year term) in East Hanover, South Annville, and West Cornwall Townships. One Auditor (2 year term) in Bethel and East Hanover Townships.

REFERENDUM: One liquor referendum in Cleona Borough for all registered voters; Vote Yes or No.

VOTER INFORMATION

In accordance with the law, notice is hereby given that on Friday, May 24, 2019 at 9:00 A.M., in the office of the Lebanon County Commissioners, the computation and canvassing of the returns of the Municipal Primary Election held on May 21, 2019, will publicly commence and will continue in the manner provided by law. Any petition to challenge the votes on the direct recording electronic voting system shall be filed no later than five (5) days after the completion of the computational canvassing of all the returns of the county by the County Board of Elections.

ABSENTEE BALLOT DEADLINE

Applications for a civilian absentee ballot must be received in the Voter Registration Office, Room 209, Municipal Building, Lebanon PA, 17042 by 5:00 P.M. on Tuesday, May 14, 2019. POSTMARKS NOT ACCEPTED. The voted ballot must be received in this same office by 5:00 P.M. on Friday, May 17, 2019.

EMERGENCY VOTING

If a qualified elector becomes ill or is called away on business or duties which fact was not known prior to the absentee ballot application deadline of May 14, 2019, he or she is entitled to complete and submit an Emergency Absentee Ballot Application at any time prior to 5:00 P.M. on Friday, May 17, 2019. Call (717) 228-4428 to inquire.

GRANTING OF ASSISTANCE

Although there will be an ADA touch screen unit at each polling precinct; a voter is still entitled to request assistance if it is so marked in the poll book or if he or she completes a declaration of assistance at the polling precinct. Anyone except an employer, a union representative, or a judge of election may assist the elector.

REGISTRATION STATUS

PROVISIONAL BALLOTS

Federal and State law provide voters with the opportunity to cast a provisional ballot under certain circumstances. County election officials will examine the provisional ballots within seven days after an election to determine if the individual voting that ballot was entitled to vote at the election district in the election.

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO CAST A PROVISIONAL BALLOT:

- If you feel you are registered to vote in a certain election district, but your name does not appear in the poll book and election officials cannot determine your registration
- If you do NOT have the proper form of identification when you appear to vote for the first time or the first time in a precinct
- If you are not registered in the political party of which you claim to be registered.

COMPLAINTS

Federal and State law provides voters with the opportunity to file a complaint based on the belief that a state or local elections official or employee has violated the provisions of Title III of the federal Help America Vote Act of 2002. If you believe election officials have failed to comply with this act, you can access the Notice and Statement of Complaint by visiting www.dos.pa.gov and select File A Complaint.
